Process to Reserve a Puppy:

- 1) First complete and submit a Puppy Application. This is not a commitment yet on your part, just the 1st step in our process.
- 2) We then set up a phone conversation to determine if we are a good fit for your needs and if you are a good fit for one of our puppies.
- 3) Upon approval, we then send you a contract to look over. Should you decide to move forward, a \$500 non-refundable Deposit and a Signed Contract will hold your place in line for a puppy from our next upcoming litter or a future litter pending availability.
- 4) Once you have committed to a puppy we keep you updated with the due date of the next litter, birth announcements, pictures, videos and valuable information needed to prepare to bring your puppy home!

Pricing

The current 2025 pricing which we have been at since 2022 has been \$2,500.00 which includes your \$500 deposit, plus applicable sales tax (\$200) which the state sets as a legal requirement for us to charge and submit to them. Thus making the total investment \$2,700.00 in 2025. All contracts are for limited registration. Full registration is available for an additional fee to a limited number of approved families per litter. Please let us know if you'd like more information on that. The remaining balance is due when you pick up your puppy at 8 weeks unless you choose to pay ahead and we can arrange that if you do.

Our total investment considers many factors, including the rising costs of raising the healthiest, quality, well-bred dogs. For this reason our prices will be increasing in 2026. \$2,790.00 that includes the \$500 deposit, plus sales tax \$210. Thus making the total investment \$3,000.00 in 2026.

Picking Order and Puppy Pick Out, Adoption Go Home Day:

Picking order is based on the order in which contracts and deposits are received. The puppy selection process starts when the puppies are around 5 weeks old. This is when you get to come and pick out your puppy (if applicable) and/or meet your new family member! Puppies will be able to go to their new homes around 8 weeks if thriving and ready. The reason our puppies go to their new homes at this age is we feel strongly that the first 8 weeks are a critical time in the development of young puppies. Important socialization skills are learned at this time, with not only the dam but with other littermates.
